In addition to good attendance, we monitor good punctuality. The school day officially starts from 08:40 with registration ending at 08:55. After this time, children are recorded as late. When children arrive late, they often join a lesson mid-way through and therefore miss the teaching input which is a big part of their learning. Over the coming weeks, members of the Senior Leadership Team will be signing in children who arrive late and will be asking for the reason so that this can be monitored over time.
