**Year 1 visit to Barleylands – Monday 22nd June 2026**

We have arranged a trip to Barleylands Farm Park on Monday 22nd June 2026. The purpose of the trip is to support our Science topic of Living Things and Habitats.

Although the children visited Barleylands last year in Reception, this year’s trip will offer them a completely new experience. The workshop we have chosen for Year 1 focuses on reptiles and links closely to our learning about habitats and the children will have the opportunity to meet a range of exotic reptiles up close and learn how different animals survive and thrive in their environments

In order to provide a wonderful experience, we are asking for a contribution of £25.00, to cover the visit and coach travel to and from the venue. Included in the price of the trip is a ticket for a free return visit to the farm for every child. However, if we do not receive sufficient contributions, we will unfortunately have to cancel this school visit. All permissions and contributions need to be completed online on the School Gateway app by Monday 1st June, when we return from half term.

We will be leaving the school shortly after 9am and travelling by coach. Please ensure your child is in school, on time, as to make the most of our visit we need to ensure we leave promptly. We aim to return to school for the end of the day.

The children will need a packed lunch with them and this needs to be clearly labelled. We ask for no products containing or with traces of nuts to be brought in. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please advise the office if you require a packed lunch to be provided for them. The children should wear their PE uniform for this trip.
