Year 3's Call of the Wild Visit – Tuesday 9th June 2026

As part of our 'Living things and their habitat' science topic next half term, we are going to be visiting Call of the Wild on the 9th of June 2026. To be able to go ahead with this visit, we are asking for a contribution of £17.00, to cover the visit and coach travel to and from the venue. If we do not receive sufficient contributions we will unfortunately have to cancel this school visit. All permission and contributions need to be paid online and consent given on School Gateway by 1st June 2026

We will be leaving school at approximately 9:15am and travelling by coach. Your child will need to be in school by 8.45am to allow us to organise the children into groups, register them and go through the final expectations. The coach should arrive back at school for approximately 3pm.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch with them, with no products containing or with traces of nuts. As well as this, the children will require a sufficient amount of drink (no fizzy). If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please advise the office if you require a packed lunch to be provided for them. Your child should wear full school uniform with suitable shoes, and they will need to bring a raincoat (in case of rain) and a suitable bag to carry their lunches.
