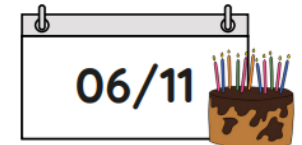


When is Saint John's Day?

Subject pronouns are not used often in Spanish, so the verb endings are important for telling you who the sentence is about.


First person singular	I	yo
Second person singular	you	tú
Third person singular	he/she/they	él/ella/elle

In Spanish we do not say, 'my mother's father', but instead we say: **El padre de mi madre** - the father of my mother.

An adjective must 'agree' with the noun it describes
That means it has to be the same gender (masculine or feminine) and number (singular or plural) as the noun
