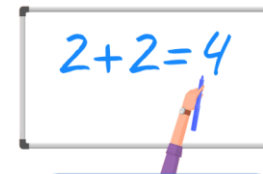

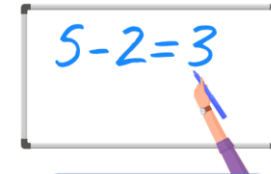
The letter 'u' in Spanish makes a sound like 'oo' in English.
uno, número, ¿y tú?

The letter 'ñ' is made with the letter n and a wavy accent called a tilde. It makes the 'ny' sound you hear in 'canyon'.
año, un niño, Señorita

The letter 'z' makes a 'th' sound as in 'think'. The letter 'c' makes the same sound in front of the letters 'i' or 'e'.
diez, cinco, feliz

Some adjectives are the same in both the masculine and feminine forms, e.g.

un caballo grande

una vaca grande

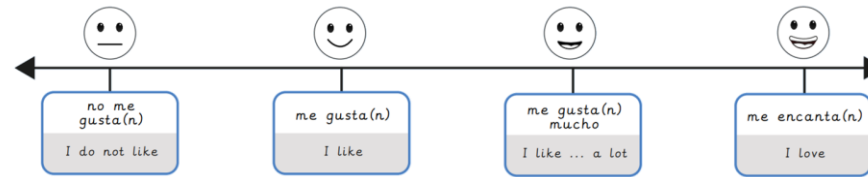
